 - Registered Member or Accredited Member of the BACP (British Association for Counselling and Psychotherapy)
 - Registered with the UKCP (UK Council for Psychotherapy)
 - BPS (British Psychological Society) Chartered Clinical or Counselling Psychologist and registered as a practitioner psychologist with the HCPC (Health and Social Care Professions Council)
 - Registered with the BPC (British Psychoanalytic Council).
 - Registered with the BAPT (British Association of Play Therapists).
- 3. Three years post-qualification experience as a counsellor, psychotherapist, or practitioner psychologist with at least 2 years experience working with primary school aged children and young people.
- 4. Experience of working in a school preferred.
- 5. Familiar with child protection legislation and procedures and committed to safeguarding children.
